



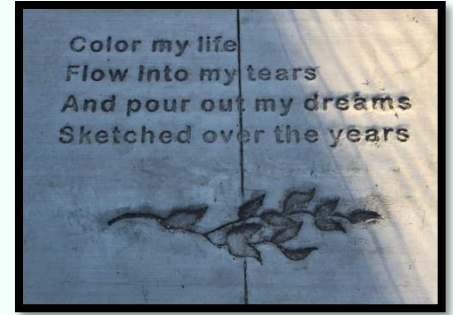

- Winners will be selected from all qualified entries, and the winning poems will be stamped in concrete, published on the City of Monrovia website, and other promotional material
