

RFQ On-Call Graffiti Removal & Pressure Washing Services

Questions and Answers

1. Would you please let me know the prior annual award amount for this service contract?

The prior annual amount for the City's on-call graffiti abatement and pressure washing agreement was an amount not-to-exceed \$15,000. The City budgeted this amount, but it did not guarantee work.

2. Do you provide a cost proposal form to submit with the RFP?

A cost proposal form is not included for submission with this RFQ.

3. Is this a prevailing wages job?

Yes. Contractor(s) shall be responsible for paying prevailing wage as specified in the California Labor Code, and for determining the appropriate Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) classification for the various employees and any subcontractors used for a particular project or service.

4. We would like to confirm if contractor with C33 license only can bid on this RFQ? Or should it be both C33 and C61 and D38.

Contractor must be licensed in the State of California and said license must authorize the work called for herein. Contractor must possess a State of California C-33 Painting License and a State of California C-61 D38 Sandblasting License and a City of Monrovia Business License during the term of this contract.

5. Who has the current contract and for how long?

The City has had a contract with Athens services since 2017.

6. Are parks part of this contract for graffiti and pressure washing?

Yes, parks are a part of this contract for graffiti and pressure washing.

7. Is the graffiti and pressure washing only for city owned property and no private property?

Yes, the graffiti and pressure washing services are only for City-owned property.

8. Can the cost of water be a passed through to the City with the invoicing? If not, how much water can we expect to use per month in gallons?

The City of Monrovia is the water utility. The current provider brings in their own water instead of using City water.

The City does not have a specific estimate for the amount of water a contractor can expect to use per month in gallons. This is due to the nature of the contract being on-call, meaning that the work can vary significantly from month to month.

The City revised the RFQ on July 18, 2024, to reflect that the Contractor will not be responsible for water usage fees if the Contractor uses City water. The City will not bill for water usage. The Contractor is required to pay a refundable deposit of \$750.00 when obtaining a hydrant travel meter.

9. What water companies are in the city?

The City of Monrovia is the city's water supplier.

10. What is the current cost of water?

The City revised the RFQ on July 18, 2024, to reflect that the Contractor will not be responsible for water usage fees if the Contractor uses City water. The City will not bill for water usage. The Contractor is required to pay a refundable deposit of \$750.00 when obtaining a hydrant travel meter.

11. Are these on-call services only? In other words, will the contractor provide services only when called out or will he be required to provide service crew(s) on-site the six-days per week?

Services are on-call. Historically, there are weekly call-outs for an estimated total of 10-15 sites per month.

12. Will the contractor provide proactive eradication or simply what is called in?

The contractor will only provide services that are called in.

13. Who has been providing these services to the city?

14. Please provide historical data (number of sites serviced and square total footage) for graffiti removal, weekly, monthly or yearly.

Historically, there are weekly call-outs for an estimated total of 10-15 sites per month.
