TITLE: Selection of Officers for Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee, Resolution No. K2026-01

OBJECTIVE: To affirm the selection of three officers – Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary – from among the members of the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee

BACKGROUND: On November 5, 2019, Monrovia voters approved the *Keep Revenue Local Sales and Use Tax* (Measure K) ballot measure, which institutes a local 0.75% transactions and use sales tax to collect funds to be spent only in Monrovia.

As part of the discussions leading up to the election, the City Council expressed the desire to form a citizen advisory committee in order to promote transparency and awareness. On September 17, 2019, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2019-52 to formally establish the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee. Following the adoption of the resolution, the City Council appointed the original Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee members on January 7, 2020, with a term that ran from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2024.

ANALYSIS: On September 3, 2024, the Monrovia City Council appointed three new members and reappointed two members to serve on the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee (“Committee”). Committee members shall be appointed for 4-year terms and the main goals of the Committee are as follows:

Responsibilities of the Committee

Pursuant to Resolution No. 2019-52, the responsibilities of the Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee include the following:

- Receive and comment on annual reports from City staff each fiscal year on revenues and expenditures from the sales tax; and
- Review and comment on annual spending plans prepared by City staff.

Format and Frequency of Meetings

Pursuant to Resolution No. 2019-52, all meetings of the committee will be open and public meetings, and this committee will be a standing committee for the purposes of the Brown Act. Additionally, the Committee is required to meet on at least an annual basis.

Selection of Officers

As a formality, Staff is recommending that the Committee establish certain roles to help better facilitate meeting decorum. The officers' roles include Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary. Below is a description of the responsibilities of each role:

- Chair shall be responsible for managing meetings and leading the proceedings.
- Vice Chair shall be responsible for performing the duties of the Chair in his or her absence.
- Secretary shall be responsible for reviewing the minutes taken by Staff for each meeting.

Each position will be held for one year, and each position will be reselected in December of the following year or at the first meeting thereafter (e.g. the Chair that is selected will serve from March 2026 until March 2027).

For the selection of Officers, members have the opportunity to nominate themselves for the available positions and finalize the positions through discussion to reach consensus. The current Chair will facilitate the selection of the new Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary, and the current Chair will conduct the remainder of the meeting. If consensus is not reached through this process, a majority vote of the five-member Committee may be held, which would require three (3) affirmative votes to select each contested position

OPTIONS: The following options are presented for the Advisory Committee's consideration:

1. Approve the selection of officers for the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee and the policies and procedures governing the Committee, as outlined in Resolution No. K2026-01.
2. Request additional information from Staff before taking action.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends Option 1, affirming the selection of officers for the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee.

COMMITTEE ACTION REQUIRED: If the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee concurs, the appropriate action would be a motion to adopt Resolution No. K2026-01.

RESOLUTION NO. K2026-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE MONROVIA MEASURE K CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF MONROVIA, CALIFORNIA, AFFIRMING THE SELECTION OF OFFICERS PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. 2019-52 OF THE MONROVIA CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2019, the City Council voted to approve the call for a special election on November 5, 2019, at which time Monrovia voters were asked to consider approval of Measure K – Keep Monrovia Revenue Local Sales and Use Tax ballot measure, which would institute a local 0.75% transactions and use sales tax to collect funds to be spent only in Monrovia; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2019-52 establishing a Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee composed of five members to be appointed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, On November 5, 2019, Monrovia voters approved the Keep Revenue Local Sales and Use Tax (Measure K) ballot measure;

WHEREAS, on September 3, 2024, the City Council appointed five members to the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2019-52, this Committee shall discharge its advisory duties as follows:

- Receive and comment on annual reports from City staff each fiscal year on revenues and expenditures from the sales tax; and
- Review and comment on annual spending plans prepared by City staff.

WHEREAS, this Committee has been formed and the initial meeting of this appointed Committee has occurred on March 17, 2021;

WHEREAS, the Committee members have been sworn in as public officials by the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary have been selected by a majority vote of the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee; and by this Resolution the Committee affirms its actions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MONROVIA MEASURE K CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE:
