Monrovia Days Committee is giving away over \$12,000 to local Monrovia non-profits!

Is your organization looking for an innovative fundraising activity?

Be a part of this exciting 3-day Community Festival and raise awareness about your organization while you also fundraise!

Again this year, local non-profits serving the Monrovia Community, can provide volunteers to work a game booth at Monrovia Days and earn \$50 per booth per hour of service! The Monrovia Days Committee will provide the game booths, the games, and the prizes; all you need to do is provide the volunteers!

Limited opportunities are available and priority will be giving to organizations serving Monrovia youth. Applications must be received no later than **Friday, April 24 at 5:00 pm**. If space is available, a single organization may host more than one booth or more than one day.

Program Guidelines

- All approved organizations must be a **bonafide** local non-profit serving the Monrovia community.
- **All organizations must identify a single point of contact who will attend a 1-hour training prior to the Monrovia Days weekend, on May 6 at 6:00 pm at the Monrovia Community Center.**
- All organizations must provide a minimum of two volunteers at all **time**, and one of the volunteers must be an adult.
- Submitting an application does not guarantee your participation. Staff will be in touch with your organizations point of contact, following the end of the application period, sometime after April 24.
- Each organization will be responsible for coordinating with their volunteers.
- A single day will **not** be broken into multiple shifts by multiple organizations. Each day, each booth will be assigned to a single organization.
- All interested organizations must submit a W-9 to the City of Monrovia along with their application.
